Calaveras County Launches 2021 Redistricting Website

Every ten years, local governments are required to use new census data to redraw their district lines. The 2020 Census data is expected to be received by October, 2021. This fall, the County will review the data and determine if the supervisorial district boundaries need to be reapportioned to equally divide the population between the five districts.

Where can I learn more? On May 13, 2021, a county redistricting website was launched, <https://elections.calaverasgov.us/Redistricting>. The website contains information about the County redistricting process, how you can get involved in the process, and a redistricting timeline.

A mapping tool is also available on the website. This tool allows residents to draw their community of interest map: <https://elections.calaverasgov.us/Redistricting/Community-of-Interest>. What is a Community of Interest? A community of interest is a neighborhood, community, or group of people who have common policy concerns and would benefit from being maintained in a single district.

The first public hearing will be held in conjunction with the Board of Supervisors meeting scheduled for June 15, 2021.
