

NOTICE OF ELECTION AND NOTICE TO SUBMIT ARGUMENTS

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a special election will be consolidated with the November 3, 2026, General Election for the purpose of voting on the following bond measure:

Measure A

“To improve the quality of education, upgrade and modernize outdated classrooms, restrooms and school facilities; expand/renovate career technical education classrooms and programs; replace leaky roofs and old HVAC systems; shall Calaveras Unified School District’s measure be adopted authorizing \$66,800,000 of Bonds at legal rates, estimated levies averaging 4.9 cents per \$100 assessed value (\$4,750,000 annually) while bonds are outstanding, with annual audits, citizens’ oversight, all money staying local, with no projected increase to existing tax rates?”

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that arguments for or against the above measure will be accepted in the office of the County Clerk, Elections Division, at 891 Mountain Ranch Road, San Andreas, CA 95249. Arguments shall not exceed 300 words in length and shall be titled either “Argument In Favor Of Measure ____” or “Argument Against Measure ____.” Arguments must be filed no later than 4:00 p.m. on August 4, 2026.

A ballot argument shall not be accepted unless accompanied by the name or names of the person or persons submitting it or, if submitted on behalf of an organization, the name of the organization and the name of at least one of its principal officers. No more than five signatures shall appear with any argument. All arguments must also be accompanied by a statement that the argument is true and correct to the best of their knowledge and belief.

If more than one argument for and one argument against the measure is received, the selection will be made pursuant to the provisions of the Elections Code 9503.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that if an argument in favor of and an argument against the measure is submitted, copies will be mailed to the respective authors. The authors may prepare and submit a rebuttal argument not to exceed 250 words in length. Rebuttal arguments must also be accompanied by a statement that the argument is true and correct to the best of his/her/their knowledge and belief. The deadline for filing a rebuttal argument will be 4:00 p.m. on August 7, 2026.
